Language that generally gives the agent the power to execute an inter vivos trust or specifically gives the agent the power to execute a special needs trust is acceptable. It are not the Settlor - Photocopy of Power of Attorney, Letters of Guardianship, Letters of servatorship or other court order establishing your authority to open the trust on behalf of Settlor.
